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Shopping Mall

INTRODUCTION

The Major BBS is a multi-user Bulletin Board system that supports up to 256 users simultaneously. Standard user services include electronic mail, Teleconferencing, Forums, File Libraries, and much more. The Shopping Mall provides these online services to merchants and buyers of goods and services:

- Searching for goods and services
- Specifying and pricing items
- Calculating discounts, shipping charges, sales tax, etc.
- Ordering and invoicing

Merchants are specifically designated users of your Bulletin Board System. Buyers may be any users on your system. A buyer transmits an order to a merchant in the form of an attachment to an electronic mail message.

When you create a store, you designate a specific User-ID as the manager or merchant of the store. You can't assign a User-ID more than one store. (To give one *person* control of multiple stores, have him sign up with multiple User-IDs.) If you only have one vendor of goods or services, you might use the multiple-merchant feature to represent different departments, or types of products, under the responsibility of different salesmen.

This manual describes the unique features of the Shopping Mall. You will want to read the Systems Operations Manual for The Major BBS before you read this manual.

INSTALLATION

Instructions for installing or upgrading the Shopping Mall:

(If you haven't installed The Major BBS yet, do that now.)

1. **A: INSTALL** Put the diskette in your floppy drive. Type "A:INSTALL" at the DOS prompt. Follow the instructions.
Introductory Menu When software installation or upgrade is complete, the Introductory Menu appears.

Next are the steps for putting a brand new Shopping Mall online. We'll walk you through adding a new selection to your Menu Tree. (If you're already an expert on Menu Tree, especially if you've designed your own custom menu screens, just make a new module page somewhere and then skip to step 10. If you're upgrading to a new version of the Shopping Mall, also skip to step 10.)

Guidelines for putting a brand new Shopping Mall online:

2. **2 = Menu Tree Design** Create a menu selection for your new service. First, choose 2 from the Introductory Menu.
3. (use the arrow keys to point to a menu page)
< Enter > Choose an existing menu page and move the cursor around until it points to it (or create a new menu page and point to it). This will become the "parent menu" for your new service.
< Enter > Hit <Enter> to bring up the parent menu page for editing.
4. **< Enter >**
< Enter >
< Enter > ,... Choose an unused menu selection field and keep hitting <Enter> until the cursor points to it.
5. **< select char >** Hit a select character to create a new menu selection and sub-page.
< description > Enter the information on this sub-page.
< key required > Name the destination page carefully, so that users can use it in the "GO" command.
< destination page > Save the new page. (You've just created a new menu page, and now we're going to change it into a module page.)
< Enter >
6. **< Esc >** Escape out of editing the parent menu page.
7. **< right arrow >**,

- < down arrow >* ,... Use the arrow keys to point to the new menu page that you created (it will appear white on color screens).
- < Enter >* Hit *< Enter >* to bring up the new menu page for editing.
8. *< down arrow >* Change the menu page into a module page.
< Enter >
- < GO command specs >*
< module name > Choose the module name from a list of modules by scrolling up and down and hitting *< Enter >* .
- < Enter >* Leave the command string blank for now. This will cause your module page to bring up a sub-menu of services when users select it online.
- < Enter >* Save the new module page
9. *< F10 >* Exit Menu Tree Design

Testing the Shopping Mall:

10. 5 = GO Bring up the BBS.
11. *< F7 >* Log on locally as the Sysop user, and select
 SYSOP the new service online from the appropriate menu
 ...

Now you've installed, assembled, and tested your new Shopping Mall.

FEATURES

- Multiple merchants (vendors)
- Each merchant manages a store
- Multiple departments per store
- Order Invoicing
- Automatic invoice numbering
- Invoice is generated and displayed for the customer
- Invoice (serving also as the purchase order) gets transmitted to the merchant as an attachment to an electronic mail message
- Separate "bill-to" and "ship-to" addresses optional for each buyer

- State sales tax, including exemption for resellers

Buyer services

- Seek merchants by company name or product category
- Seek products by merchant product description
- Select products from a menu and enter quantities
- Specify color and size of items
- Review and edit orders
- Total and place orders

Merchant Services

- Specify products: descriptions, price, weight, color or size selection
- Discountable inventory
- Specify multiple payment methods, with associated discounts or surcharges
- Specify multiple shipping methods, with various charging methods: flat fee, percent of total charge, or by weight
- Store descriptions

Sysop Privileges

- Assign / Delete merchants
- Maintain product categories
- Assign merchants to product categories
- Shopping Mall introductory message
- Allow merchants to handle up to 6 different credit cards

Prices and amounts: up to \$2,000,000,000.00

General information: (limited only by disk space)

Store name (merchant's company name): 29 characters

Store welcome message: 1920 characters

General store information: (limited only by disk space)

Maximum number of payment methods per merchant: 6

Maximum number of shipping methods per merchant: 6

Product category key: 6 characters

Product category description: 30 characters

Product I.D.: 12 characters

(note: customers order by sequential menu number, not by product I.D.)

Short product description: 30 characters

Long product description: 1920 characters

Product size selection: 15 characters

Product color selection: 15 characters

Each invoice can apply to only one store, but can include products from multiple departments.

BUYER SERVICES

When a user first enters the Shopping Mall (typically by selecting "O" from the main menu), he is presented with the following menu:

The first option, "G", presents to the user a description of the Shopping Mall in general, with instructions for choosing a store, seeking products and services, and placing an order. This message can be very long, and comes from the ASCII text file ORDPRC.INS, which you can edit with a text editor, such as DOS EDIT or EDLIN.

Selecting a Store

A user can select a store using either Shopping Mall menu options "L" (list product categories) or "E" (enter a store). If a user selects "L", he gets a list of product categories, such as:

If there is only one department in the store, the user bypasses the Department Menu and goes right to the Store Options Menu.

Searching for Products

The buying user can search for products either:

- Indexed alphabetically by product description, searching all stores at once, or by
- Browsing through the products in a specific store.

The index search tells a user what merchant sells each product. The products may be listed starting from any letter in the alphabet:

Now the buying user has the opportunity to get more information on a product, and to order it:

GalactiBox (unpopulated):

The GalactiBox(tm) is an AT-Size card enclosure with slots for up to 16 standard 8-bit I/O option cards inside. It comes with an interface card for the XT/AT/EISA bus and a connecting cable. The GalactiBox can be used as a standard 16-slot "expansion chassis" if desired, but its real power comes from its ability to "multiplex" a group of otherwise identical XT/AT/EISA option cards into software-distinguishable I/O addresses.

This "multiplexing" has two modes, individually DIP-switch configurable on each of the 16 slots: GalactiBox Mode, in which the slot is enabled if and only if the high-order six I/O address bits match its slot and chassis address; and Universal Mode, which allows each slot to be individually enabled or disabled, under software control, on the basis of a bit setting in the "Universal Disable Register". Two 8259 interrupt controller chips are provided, jumper-selectable between interrupt levels 2, 3, 4, and 5 on both inputs and outputs, the latter being available either separately or as a combined, edge-regenerating signal.

The GalactiBox can be used with modems, FAX cards, voice/DTMF interface cards, serial cards, or any 8-bit I/O option cards, to expand the hardware addressing potential of these cards for multi-line, multi-user, or multi-tasking applications. Up to 4 boxes may be connected to a single machine, for expansion potential up to 64 slots.

In this configuration, the box is unpopulated and can support 16 additional devices (ie. SupraModem 2400i or the SupraModem 2400 Plus modems).

At this point, the order has not yet been submitted to the merchant, allowing the user to order more items and to review his order. When the user exits from the "B" (browse) option of the store options menu, he is given the following choices:

To add more products from this merchant to his order, the buying user selects "B" from the above options. In this case he can view the merchant's list of products from the start. To review or modify his order, the user can select "R":

To submit an order to the merchant, the buying user selects "T" from the above options. The first time that a buying user places any order from any merchant on your system, the user is asked to enter specific customer data:

- Billing address and phone number
- Shipping address and phone number
- Credit Card (name as it appears on card)

With each subsequent order after the first, the user is only asked to verify this information, and is given the chance to modify it. If your Shopping Mall has been configured to ask for a tax resale number (see page 18), then the buying user is now asked for it:

If you have a "tax resale number", and you are buying these goods for resale under it, enter it here; otherwise use "NONE".

Your tax resale number (hit RETURN to use "12001-3390-0032"):

Now the user is asked to choose his payment method. Up to six payment methods may be configured individually by each merchant, for example:

1. VISA
2. MasterCard
3. American Express
4. C.O.D.
5. Prepayment
6. Purchase Order

Choose method of payment: 1

In the case of a credit card, the buying user must enter his card number and expiration date. Credit card numbers must pass the Kuhn formula test to be accepted. In the case of a purchase order, the buyer must enter his purchase order number. The merchant can specify various charges or discounts based upon the payment method and size of the order. More on this below.

Next, the buying user must next select the shipping method:

1. UPS Ground
2. UPS Blue (2nd Day)
3. UPS RED (Next Day)
4. U.S. Mail
5. Outside-U.S. Express
6. ZXI Laser Express

Again, the shipping methods are configurable by the merchant, and various charges may be configured based upon the weight or amount of the order. Now the order is totaled and the invoice is generated:

*** ORDER PROCESSED ***

This same information is placed into an attachment to an electronic mail message and is automatically transmitted to the merchant's user account, serving as a purchase order. The buying user can review or erase this order using the electronic mail service. To find the order, the buying user may type "RF." from the Electronic Mail menu of The Major BBS, selecting: Read / messages From the user / starting with the first message.

MERCHANT SERVICES

In summary, the merchant user may:

- Maintain information about himself, including:
 - Company name, address, and phone number
 - State sales tax rate
 - Discount rate
 - Invoice numbering
 - Summary
- Specify welcome message, seen by users when they "enter" his store.
- Specify detailed store information, seen by users when they select "G" from the Store Options Menu.
- Specify payment methods, with charges or discounts
- Specify shipping methods, with charges
- Specify products for sale, including:
 - Brief and long descriptions
 - Price
 - Weight
 - Whether the buyer must choose a color or size
 - Whether the item is discountable or not

## Payment Methods

Option "P" from the Merchant Options Menu selects the payment methods available to users who buy from this merchant. The existing payment methods (those already entered by the merchant) are shown by number, and can be edited (add, delete, or modify) by typing the number, for example:

You can apply optional charges for the use of this shipping method by either a flat fee, a percentage of the total sales amount, 1st ounce/add'l ounce, or 1st pound/add'l pound.

To charge a flat fee, just enter the amount and press RETURN. To charge a percentage, follow the amount with a percent '%' sign. For 1st/add'l charges, enter the first amount, a comma, the second amount, and either 'OZ' for ounces, or 'LB' for pounds.

Examples:

5.50 ..... Flat fee of \$5.50  
6% ..... 6 percent of the total sales amount  
3.50,1.75 OZ ... \$3.50 for the first ounce, \$1.75 for each addnl ounce

If a merchant specifies different sizes or colors, then buying users will be asked to specify this information, although it will not affect pricing. If the merchant specifies that a product is discountable, then his global discount will apply to these items. The weight of a product may affect the shipping charges, depending on the merchant's specifications for the shipping method selected by the buying user.

## Moving and Copying Products between Departments

You can copy or move product information from one department to another within a store. First enter the destination department of the store. Then choose the "I"=Update inventory option. "M"=Move transfers the product and removes it from the source department. "C"=Copy duplicates the product into the destination department.

## Specifying Store Information

Option "W" from the Merchant Options Menu allows the merchant user to edit the welcome message that buying users get when they enter his store.

Option "G" from the Merchant Options Menu allows the merchant to type in a very long description of his store (screen breaks are handled automatically). This description is given to users when they select "G" from the Store Options Menu. The merchant will not get a chance to edit this file -- he can only enter it all over again from scratch.

## ON-LINE SYSOP PRIVILEGES

The Sysop user can do anything that the Merchant users can do, plus the following:

- Assign or delete merchants
- Maintain product categories
- Assign merchants to product categories
- Specify the welcoming message of the Shopping Mall

Note that the data in lines 1 through 4 of the merchant information come initially from the account of the User-ID who is assigned as merchant. Now you, as the Sysop user, or the new merchant user (in this case, user "Grambo"), may enter the Merchant Options Menu and specify the remaining information.

## Product Categories

Product categories help buying users find merchants with products or services in which the buyer is interested. Buyers can list all product categories in the Shopping Mall, and within the categories, list the merchants who sell products in that category. As the Sysop user, you can specify new product categories, and associate them with merchants. For example:

If some buying users will be resellers, with state sales tax exemption privileges, you may set configuration variable RESALE to "YES". In this case, users will be asked for the sales tax exemption number after they complete their order.

**NOTE: MOST STATES REQUIRE THAT YOU HAVE A SIGNED TAX CARD ON FILE IN ORDER TO HONOR A TAX RESALE NUMBER -- THIS PROGRAM DOES NOT ALTER THAT RESPONSIBILITY!**

## **Credit Card Information**

These options allow you to predefine the credit card payment methods that your shopping mall will accept. Any merchant in your shopping mall may choose some subset (or all or none) of these credit cards for his store.

You define credit cards by entering a name for the credit card, as "VISA" is defined for CCTYP1. Then specify the number of digits in each credit card number (13 or 16 for Visa). The prefix specifies the starting digit(s) of all of the credit cards (all Visa card numbers start with 4). To remove a credit card, simply erase the credit card name.

These options only affect the choices for new merchants, or for an existing merchant who is changing his credit card payment information.

In addition to credit card payment methods, you may also allow other payment methods, such as by purchase orders, cash, etc., but these methods should not be defined in offline Configuration. Credit cards are special because the shopping mall can do some preliminary validation of credit card numbers.
